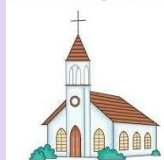

Dear Parishioner

You will notice that there are now six priests' collection envelopes in your box. We have made this change at the request of the Diocesan Office who are seeking to ensure that there are an equal number of priests' collections scheduled in every parish across the diocese.

The Diocesan Office has observed "an increasing variation in the number of priests collections in different parishes / pastoral areas over the years. In the interest of fairness and equality all parishes / pastoral areas are now asked to have the same number (6) priests' collections throughout the year. For some parishes this will mean an increased no. of collections, for some a reduction, and for others, no change.

While this need not result in a change to parishioners overall total contribution, it will ensure that all parishes / pastoral areas are operating a standardised number of collections across the diocese".
