A time for **reflecting** on where life is taking you.

A time for **Giving** and a time for **Giving Up**.

We can give up on food, drink. Good for the health as well as the soul.

But maybe it is a Lent we should remind ourselves that giving is good for us too - **it is in giving we receive**. But more important - our giving this Lent could give life to people who don't have one other than for a short time and in miserable conditions.

Almost half the people in the world live on less than €2 a day. This means a constant and desperate struggle to survive.

This Lent we, as a community, want to make a special effort to contribute to Trócaire, to help them provide the poorest and most vulnerable with the skills to lift themselves out of poverty. Ambika, a young nine year old girl, lives in one of the most isolated parts of Eastern India. In the past, her community struggled to grow food on poor quality land and had no school or clean drinking water.

With Trócaire's support the community now has the knowledge and skills they need to gain ownership of their land to improve their crops, helping families to feed themselves and earn an income. They now have their own school and clean drinking water.

Trócaire Boxes and envelopes are now available. They are in the schools, shops, Churches and homes. We are asked to place them in a visible place. The small amount we give to help those who have very little can go a long way.
