People of Inishowen

The people of Inishowen, Donegal, woke up on Monday morning to the news of an horrific accident which took the lives of 8 people. The uncle of one the young lads killed caught the reaction of the local community when he said "they were mystified and magnanimous". Mystified in that it was impossible to understand a tragedy of this magnitude in a small community. Magnanimous in that as always, the local community responded so powerfully. It is one thing having to visit a one wake house whose people have experienced a tragedy but to have to visit 8 is simply beyond our understanding.

Will those people ever forget, certainly the tragedy will be spoken of by generations to come. The present generation, especially the mothers and fathers, brothers and sisters extended families are called on to carry heavy crosses.

I think it is true to say that the shockwaves went way beyond Inishowen and Donegal. We have been praying for them every day here in our own community. We said "just picture what this would have done to us if anything like it happened here".

It is certainly a stark reminder to value life. Gay Byrne put it well during the week when he said .. " it is a reminder that all our lives are suspended by a thin thread".

Our thoughts and prayers go out on this July weekend 2010 to those broken hearted people. We pray that the good God and our Blessed Lady will give them the strength and support they need at this time.
