Meaning to Life

The Meaning to Life group - a sub-group of the Parish Pastoral Council - met during the week. Among the items discussed was a short Listening Programme with young people and parents. It was agreed that in order to give direction in the area of Christian values people should be listened to rather than impose from the top. To connect with people it is important to find out where they are at. We are now exploring how we might approach this. It is also proposed to get involved in a Study of Family life. What is the situation with people in families now and how can they be supported by the wider community?

The group is currently putting together a short pamphlet outlining initiatives taken within our Parish of Sixmilebridge + Kilmurry to connect the Christian message to the real lives of people. It was also emphasised that we should continue to 'reach out' to people who may not be regular church goers. Christ did not distinguish between people.

We are truly blessed that our local Church experiences so much goodwill within our community.
