## **First Communion Enrolment**

Fifty eight young people will receive First Communion in this Parish on 14th and 21st May. Of all the occasions in our growing up years most of us have memories of our First Communion Day. If it has stayed in our memory down through the years this must mean it's a very special day. The reasons maybe different. It could have been the 'dressing up' or the 'special meal' or 'the money'. But I believe that the real reason we remember it is the preparation that goes into it. Years ago it might have been Catechism answers. Now it is about learning our prayers and becoming more aware about God in our life. Above all it is about becoming part of the wider Christian Community gathering around the 'Table' which is the Altar to receive Jesus. This makes First Communion Day a very Sacred Event.

As our fifty eight children enrol for their First Communion and as the Parents commit to this, we Pray for them and wish them well.
