Child Protection Policy

The Diocese asked that all in Parish Ministry who have contact with Children and Vulnerable Adults should complete a Garda Vetting Form and Self Declaration Form. It will be necessary to fill this form even if you have recently done so. Garda Vetting will occur every three years. This includes Priests, Sacristans full time and part time or voluntary, Choir leaders, Eucharistic Ministers and any person involved in Children's Ministry or activities i.e. Play and Pray.

Building Resilience in Young People

These talks are for everyone. It is important we avail of them. The speakers are extremely well qualified. Each topic has a practical message for all age groups.

Our first talk: **Depression:** What exactly is it? is of huge importance for our time. Depression has become a major problem in Ireland. What exactly is it? The more we understand it, the better equipped we can deal with it. It is a common human experience that can affect anyone. It impacts on young people, young parents, people in different stages of life coping with change, relationships etc.

Our second talk: **The Spiritual Dimension of Life** will connect again to all our lives. Liam communicates through story, lived experience, music and through these gives meaning to life. He speaks a language which helps us to understand. There is a hunger for Meaning in all our lives. Our third talk will be given by a young person who at a very young age spent over two years in Northern Uganda working with formerly abducted child soldiers and their children, re-integrating them back into the community. This talk will have two special messages - how resilient people can be when faced with adversity and secondly how genuinely idealistic and committed young people can be in responding to others. Fiona is one of our parishioners. We strongly urge you to attend these three talks. More detailed information on the speaker and topic will be available before each talk.
