Parish Hall Kilmurry Invitation to Tendor

At a meeting held in April 2010 the Sixmilebridge / Kilmurry Parish Pastoral Council unanimously agreed that

"The Parish Pastoral Council would retain ownership of the hall." maintain the hall to a suitable standard and ensure that the hall is managed as a Parish Facility going forward as a matter of priority".

Plans are now underway to renovate the hall and we are now in a position to seek tenders with the closing date for receipt of tenders being set at August 20th.

An invitation is extended to all contractors to tender and a full schedule of the works is available in the Parish Office.

The project will include

the replacement of the roof at the rear of the building, the upgrading of the toilet areas.

the upgrading of the kitchen area.
