If He said *"I want you to bring peace to your homes, to give encouragement to the depressed, to speak words of comfort and consolation to the lonely. And then remember we have the Good News. *"If Jesus walked into our Church today?"* But of course we know that He is present with us and that He is in fact urgently looking for helpers.
