The Past Week

During the past week we gave people the opportunity to take time out in this parish. This idea was to help us reflect on some of the realities of life. For example, on Thursday morning we reflected on a piece from the Reading at Mass which said—"if we can endure pain it will lead to patience and patience leads to perseverance and perseverance to hope. Everyone is looking for hope. But it won't come without pain, patience, perseverance. Maybe we are convinced it will be handed to us. It won't, nor should it. That was the mistake we made before. Election promises based on easy solutions to our current situation will lead to more cynicism and despair.

On Monday we reflected on young people and the example we should be giving them now. On Tuesday the Spirituality of St. Brigid—connecting to nature, respecting the seasons, space for God - brought us to reflect on a world outside ourselves we cannot continue abusing. We Blessed Candles on Wednesday night and with them we blessed throats. Same on Thursday. Health, healing, light, hope became central to our thoughts. We visited every class in both schools, blessed the children, prayed for health, noted the sacred space in each room pointing to the message - leave space for God in their hearts and homes. We visited the housebound.

All in all we were delighted with the response. It was way beyond what we expected. Over 1200 people had their throats Blessed. The depth of faith in this parish is enormous. Thank God for it. Lets continue to dig deep and give people the opportunity to re-discover the soul and nourish it.
