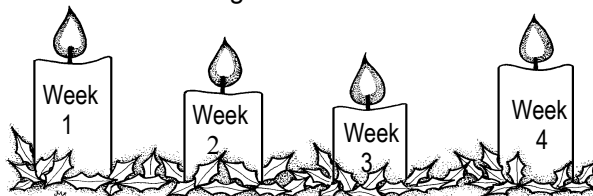
Monday 8th December is **Feast of the Immaculate Conception**
