

Unhappy is Love Without the Death of the Saviour

Meaning To Life Life - Death - Resurrection - New Life

To some degree, everyone in our culture is now confronted with the question of Meaning to Life. And it is not easy to find answers to the question many people are asking -

How and where do we find help to live a decent, Meaningful Life? There is no doubt the answers are to be found in a faith that Jesus came, lived, died but Rose Again to help us find that Meaning. But that faith has weakened.

Up to recently a very important concern was what would happen to you after you died:

> Where would you go? Would you make to Heaven? What about the possibility of hell?

> or would you at the very least make it to Purgatory?

This weighed heavily on people? There was a real fear behind these questions. This way of thinking has practically disappeared for younger generations. Gay Byrne, for example, reflecting back on the series The Meaning of Life on R.T.E. says that what amazed him is that in the end, how little thought people had given to this question of "what happens when you die?" With the disappearance of that question a whole foundation that for many made sense of religion has simply disappeared. There was a very close connection between attending Mass and being aware of the dead and the dying.


But these questions about death and life-after-death have been replaced by another series of questions. They are centred on the Meaning and meaningfulness of life. Surely there is a connection. If we believe in Jesus that our faith tell us - He died but He rose from the dead. Meaning to Life makes more sense if we believe in a life after death. Fundamentally, the story of the Resurrection is the only story we ever need to hear as Christians, because if this story is not true, then meaning to life is meaningless.

If Christ did not rise from the dead, all else is worthless. Death is now not the last word. We don't have to live as if death is our master. Death is not the final reality.
