Notre Dame de Paris - Our Lady of Paris - has been one of the most enduring and symbolic monuments of the French capital and among the most celebrated Cathedrals in Europe. To many Parisians, the 850 year old landmark is quite simply the heart of their city. It's the Cathedral with one of the longest and richest of histories, the site of Royal weddings, the Consecration of Napoleon Bonaparte as Emperor and the Beatification of Joan of Arc. These and many other special happenings and ceremonies took place in this cathedral. These were grandiose occasions in Cathedral church. No one knows how the fire started but 1000's just stood speechless, many wept as their Church was burning.

Two Thoughts!

- 1. France is an extremely secular country the kind of place Ireland is becoming. In short this means people rely on their own power and turn away from reliance on God. Could this be a sign that people should consider turning back to God.? During this Holy Week we might reflect on this.
- 2. What does our local Church mean to us? Are they not sacred places where people gather for special occasions from birth to death, places we gather too to thank God for the week that was, thank Him for life and who we are and ask Him to help us through the following week.
