The Joy of Love

Pope Francis in a major Document published last week is warning against a Church which could be out of touch. The Archbishop of Armagh, Eamon Martin commenting on the document said: 'He cautions us that if the Church resorts to a whole body of doctrine, moral and bioethical teaching, and fails to take account of the real lives of people, then the Church will be out of touch.'

"He encourages us to go out, to reach out, go out to where people are at.' "We have got so used to the Church in Ireland staying put and inviting people to come to us, some people might find this challenging but a truly Christ like missionary Church must reach out.' Pope's very warm and distinctive style.

This is a major document about Family, Marriage, Relationships. The Pope says that "at times we have proposed a far too abstract and almost artificial theological ideal of marriage, far removed from the practical and concrete possibilities of real families. The document tries to set out clearly the beautiful vet demanding teaching of Jesus and to teach that to men and women whose lives are lived within their own human frailties and failures."

This Document has been warmly welcomed. He calls on us to 'get in touch with the family, listen to them, don't use moral law, if people are in other unions welcome them into the Church.

In our Parish we have tried to reach out to where people are at. Pope Francis is a 'breath of fresh air' for a Church he encourages to look forward rather than back.
