

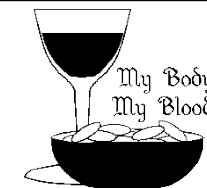

Baptisms take place at 12.00 Noon on Sundays in Sixmilebridge + Kilmurry

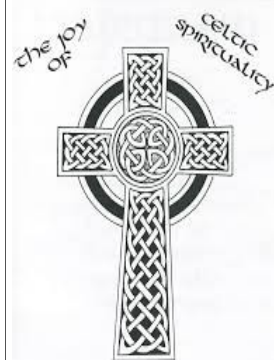
We extend our sympathy to Bernie Fitzgerald, Beechwood Grove, on the death of her mother **Patricia Madden R.I.P.** in Clonlara.
