Changes in Responses at Mass

This September we see the introduction of changes in the congregational responses and text in the new edition of the Missal: This is a directive from the Vatican to the English speaking World to ensure that we are all saying the same thing when we celebrate Mass, the Missal is carefully translated into each language from the original which is Latin, the official language of the Church. The Mass itself has not changed. When we begin to use the new Missal there will be cards available in the Church with the new responses highlighted on them. We will move as gently as possible in our Parish with this change.
