COVID 19 Announcement

In light of the latest Government Announcement where only 15 people are allowed to gather outdoors - our Masses on Sunday will have to be indoors with a limit of up to 50 people attending. People are being advised to use their own judgement with regard to attending Mass. We will have outdoor speakers if people wish to stay in their cars. Stewards will be in place to direct people. Holy Communion will be distributed after Mass. Please follow the guidance of the stewards. We advise people in the Church to remain seated during Mass. The toilet facility will only be open in case of emergency.

Face Coverings in the Church in solidarity with the vast majority of our fellow citizens who actively promote and pursue as safe an environment as possible - in their homes, their places of work and places where they shop or gather, the Diocese of Killaloe now 'strongly recommends' the wearing of face coverings in addition to the continuation of social distancing and sanitising in all its Churches and buildings as public Masses and services continue.
