 Sixmilebridge and Kilmurry.

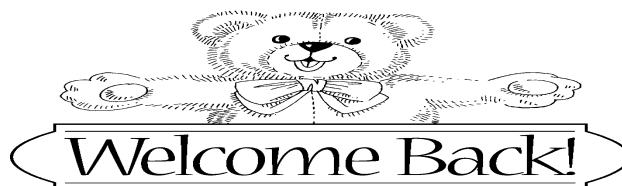
