

Jesus went away to a quiet place.

He needed to do that. But the crowds followed Him. They were hungry - spiritually. His was a voice of **Hope**. Of all the voices at the time His was the One that made sense. Its interesting that they followed Him into a quiet place. He was looking for that quiet place for Himself but the crowds hungered so much for Him that they came after Him. When He had nourished them spiritually He was told they were hungry but there was very little food -

Five Loaves and Two Fish. They put that little basket in front of Him and He transformed it to feed everybody.

What is all this saying to us? We all need a quiet place - to do what? To give time to him so that we can hear Him.

We are hungry - spiritually. There is every indication that there is a spiritual hunger in Ireland today. Is this not evident in the fact that people in community after community across the country are being called on to tackle the problem of drug-taking.

The hearth of real spirituality in our time is leading to escapisms of all kind. We obviously need to take the cue from this time. This means that now and again we need time to withdraw from everything around us and turn to Him and listen to what He has to say to us.

I think part of what He is saying to us is the story of the Loaves and Fishes - give me what little you have and I will give it back to you an hundred fold.
