On the 7th of December, a candle was lit in the Grotto of Christ's Birth in the Church of the Nativity, in Bethlehem. This flame was taken by Israeli and Palestinian Scouts to Tel Aviv airport where it travelled to Vienna and after an International Service which will be held on the 12th of December. Scouts help to pass on the Peace Light throughout Europe and beyond. Irish Scouts are collecting it in Hollyhead in Wales on Thursday 17th and after an Ecumenical Service in Fairview it is being passed to Scout Groups throughout the Country to bring to the local parishes.
