A Time to Remind us of the Significance of Jesus coming as a Child.

Christmas is a time of great excitement for some, a lot of preparations. It's a time for memories, a time especially for home and family. At this time we remember in a special way loved ones who have gone to their eternal reward and people who are grieving.

In short it's a time of mixed emotions. Above all its about a child - God sent His Son. Because the world needed a stark reminder and a call to all of us that we need to restore a sense of God, a sense of the Sacred in our lives otherwise we will lose a sense of meaning to life and death.

Last Tuesday Fintan O'Toole wrote his weekly piece in the Irish Times. It was headed:

"We worship one homeless child while ignoring 4,000 others."

Christmas reminds us above all else of a homeless child. We will be seeing it in Churches, Cribs, School Nativity plays and Christmas cards. It will inspire feelings of awe and devotion and warmth.

But it should redden our cheeks with shame. While we are worshipping a homeless child, who is at the heart of Christmas, almost 4000 children in Ireland will wake up on Christmas morning in places that are not homes.

There are no Angels or Shepherds coming to adore our homeless children; no star from the East to hang over them. They don't need them. They do need us as a people to turn helplessness into shame and shame to anger. Maybe our world needs a stark reminder again.


