Parish Pastoral Council

At the Parish Pastoral Council Meeting on Tuesday night
 the Chairman gave a brief account of the various initia-
 tives being taken within the Parish. It was agreed to pub-
 lish this in the annual newsletter. The participation of
 people through different ministries and organisations
 within the Parish was acknowledged.

Among the items noted was the Reaching Out through
 Area Gatherings to people within these areas. It was then
 suggested that further participation could be encouraged
 by giving people in these areas the opportunity to take
 part as area representatives in the overall Parish.

Specifically there was mention of two activities:

- **Church Carers** - that areas within the Parish would take
 their turn in caring for both our Churches. In practise this
 would mean a team of 4 people within an area would vol-
 unteer to give 2 hours approximately now and again de-
 pending on the number of teams. i.e. if there are 8
 teams this would be every 8 weeks. If, you are agreeable
 in your own area to spearhead this you might give your
 name to Kay O'Dowd or Maureen Gallagher through the
 Parish Office.

- If you would be willing within your own area to distrib-
 ute parish information now and again to each house we
 would also like to hear from you through the Parish Of-
 fice.

We have always heard "**the more hands the less work.**"
 Apart from anything else this would continue to develop
 the wonderful spirit within our Parish Community.
