Mrs. Mary Ryan - 100th Birthday

We are delighted to congratulate Mrs. Mary Ryan, Cooleycasey, our new Centenarian. She celebrated her 100th birthday last Tuesday 7th February. She was born in 1912 and lived through a time of extraordinary change - Independence, Economic War, World War 1 + 2, mass Emigration of the 1940's + '50's, the New Ireland of the 1960's with its four revolutions - Communications, Industrial, Education and Religious, - the ups and downs of the '70's + '80's, the Celtic Tiger period and now the Recession. Mary Ryan took all these great economic and Social Changes in her stride.

She is a woman rooted in prayer, faith, family and community. She brought 11 children into the world - and had to suffer the tragic loss of her daughter Kitty in an accident in 1998. Her family adore her. Their love and care has enabled her to live in her own home. They say they are only giving back a little of what they got from her.
