## 'Of Course I Want to'

These are the stand-out words from the Message today. No matter what the problem, not matter who the person, Jesus responded with a heart and a half -

"Of course I want to". And in this case a leper - a very lonely man, away from his friends and family, and was very sick. Jesus cured him and gave him the chance to start life again. Giving someone a chance to do that is very special. That might be in the case of a person getting back their health, and we pray for that all the time. But it also might be the case of someone who, as we say 'blotted their copy book' in one way or another. Think of someone today - a member of our community, our family even who didn't get a second chance. Maybe we all need a change of heart towards a person who is suffering rejection.

Above all else Lent has to be about a change of heart. It might make a big difference to someone if you and I were willing to forgive and, or course, that includes someone we have fallen out with or think badly of. It could also include a generosity to help another, no matter what the problem.

'Of course I want to - Help - Forgive.'

And wouldn't it be wonderful too if you could avail of this Lent to give a little quiet time to God - ask Him to help you rid yourself of some disturbing emotion such as bitterness, jealousy, anger, negativity - anything that is damaging your own life. He would be more than willing to help any one of us - if we could make the effort and be humble enough to ask.
