

Beginning of Lent

Lent is an opportunity to look at our lifestyle and addictions and take some action. It is a time to promote some genuine and healing Lenten abstinence. We impose ourselves on others in conversation, taking for granted that what interests us interests everybody else... We talk too much, and too loud. In short, our ego can be overpowering. This fault is only too common, and each of us has certainly been guilty of it many times.

LISTEN and SILENT - these two words are made up of the same letters, a coincidence perhaps. Nonetheless - in order to *LISTEN* we need to be **SILENT**. If we are not **SILENT** we cannot **LISTEN**. Silence is not a characteristic of our time - more likely 'the louder the better'. That is all the more reason to cultivate silence so that we can listen to those around us and, particularly, listen to the voice of God in our lives.
