

WILL THERE BE FAITH?

During the past week we had two very significant events in the Church. One was ...

- First Confessions for 74 Children from Sixmilebridge School -We had the same for 12 children last week from Kilmurry.
- On Wednesday evening we gathered with Eucharistic Ministers and Readers to reflect on the concept of a God of Mercy and Compassion. Both evenings emphasised the importance of our Faith for life and living. Bringing Life to Faith and Faith to Life was the message for both gatherings.

Ours is very much a 'secular age' in which the conditions of life now discourage faith.

One of the world's great thinkers once wrote - "when a person stops believing in God he/she doesn't believe in nothing. They believe in anything." If we ignore or turn our backs on God how do we determine the difference between good and evil, between right and wrong?

The children receive a wonderful grounding in the values which help to shape their lives - their parents and some grandparents were with them on Tuesday night. It is vital that the values they learn at school are central to home and community life. Pope Francis has asked us to set aside this year to reflect on the God of Mercy, on Jesus who is central to the life of the Christian, to nourish our relationship with Him and to live it in the most practical of ways.

It's an old saying - we never miss the water until the well runs dry. The question 'will there be Faith?' is a pressing one for us all now.
