

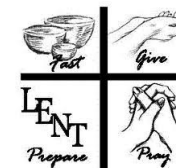

"I'm Sorry!"

That is what God is asking us to do today. The gift of this Lenten Season is that it is a natural time to take stock. The call we hear, from Jesus in the Gospel this weekend is to 'repent' which is a special type of stocktaking. It's a stock take of the mind and heart with a desire to acknowledge our weakness or stubbornness and change.

Last Wednesday night we had a powerful talk on the Eucharist - Christ in His Word and Christ in His Presence. We were told if we listen carefully to the Word it can change something in us. The reading today is calling on us to be humble enough to contact somebody we have hurt and tell them we are sorry. Think of what that could do for that other person and yourself. What a difference it could make at home.

It could change a relationship and it could change the atmosphere.

I heard at Mass today of the importance to be humble enough to say to somebody "I'm sorry I hurt you, when I said or did something or when I create a bad atmosphere at home."
