HOME - SCHOOL - PARISH PREPARING YOUNG PEOPLE FOR LIFE

Preparation of young people for Confirmation and First Communion goes on through the year - in the schools, at home, and the parish. It involves the children and their parents in a special way and it involves the Grandparents. The young people for Confirmation were recently facilitated by the teachers to reflect

- what they see are the challenges facing them now:
- What makes them feel good
- Identify the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit they receive in Confirmation, reflect on each one and how, practically, it can help them e.g. Wisdom, to know right from wrong, Courage, to stand on their own two feet and not be carried along with the crowd.

We now live in what is called the Digital Age. Growing numbers are finding it easier to communicate on the Internet than with one another. The fact that even young children are often more adept at using smart phones, tablets, and computers than the adults in their lives can only be adding to parental anxiety. Issues to do with the over-use of these is being raised as part of our preparation for Confirmation especially. These and other issues will also be raised when the Parents meet. Our parish is facilitating this as part of our preparation for the Sacraments. Could we also remember to pray for parents, young people, our homes and our schools, especially at this time.

Next Wednesday and Thursday children for First Communion will receive the Sacrament of First Penance.
