Today is the **First Sunday in Advent** and we can reflect on it as a time of waiting, watching, preparation, light and quiet reflection on the Person who is to come. It is a period of four weeks prior to Christmas. It is a season which helps us to prepare for the great feast of Christmas. The Advent Wreath is prepared and blessed on the first Sunday of Advent. This is a long standing custom in Europe. It is made from holly and evergreen leaves in the form of a circle with four candles representing each week. And one candle representing Christ. The circle reminds us of eternity which has no beginning or end. One candle is lit for each Sunday in Advent.

1st CANDLE - (purple) **THE CANDLE OF HOPE**We can have hope because God is faithful and will keep the promises made to us. Our hope comes from God.

2nd CANDLE - (purple) THE CANDLE OF PREPARATION-God kept His promise of a Saviour who would be born in Bethlehem. Preparation means to 'get ready'. Help us to be ready to welcome YOU O GOD.

3rd CANDLE - (pink) THE CANDLE OF JOY
The angels sang a message of JOY.

4th CANDLE - (purple) THE CANDLE OF LOVE The angels announced the Good News of a Saviour. God sent His only Son to earth to save us because He loves us.

5th CANDLE - (white) "CHRIST CANDLE"
The white candle reminds us that Jesus is the Spotless Lamb
of God, sent to wash away our sins! His birth was for His
death. His death was for our birth.

We pray, Almighty God in your mercy, be with us always with the help of the Holy Spirit. May the season of Advent be a time of joy, happiness, and peace for each of us, our people and our country. **CHRISTMAS BINGO - Sixmilebridge GAA Club**
