

"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God." Aid us to make peace in our families, in our country, and in the world.

"Blessed are those who are persecuted for the sake of justice, for the Kingdom of heaven is theirs."

Make us willing to suffer for the sake of right rather than to practice injustice: and do not let us discriminate against our neighbours and oppress and persecute them.
