Help us leave what is troubling us behind and help us leave by Another Road, .. The Road of Forgiveness. .. The Road of Healing.

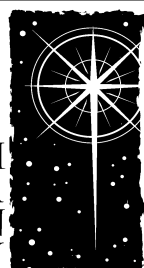
Be With Us Lord
