The only courses approved in the Diocese are the Accord Courses, the Esker pre-marriage weekend and the Mount Argus Course in Dublin. The Diocese does not accept On Line Pre marriage Courses or courses which are supplied on CD/DV as sufficient preparation for the Sacrament.

ACCORD, Catholic Marriage Care Service, is an Agency of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference. It has centres located throughout the dioceses of Ireland. Its ministry is primarily concerned with supporting the sacrament of marriage by helping couples as they prepare for marriage and offering support to them in their marriage relationship.
