 you have created, now and forever. Amen.



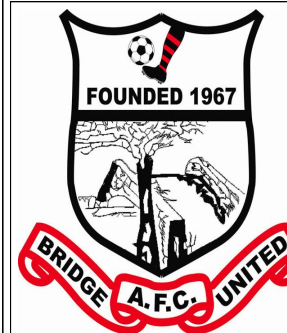
