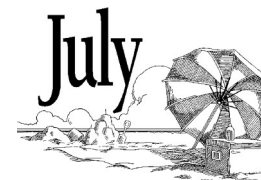

Authentic Christian love begins in the experience and acceptance of the fact that we are loved unconditionally by God. It then flows through us when we decide to act lovingly towards others.

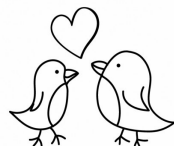

Tax Back Scheme for Eligible Charities. We thank you for your continuing support of our Parish through your weekly envelope donations and Priest Collection contribution. The Tax Back Scheme for eligible charities is a tax refund in respect of tax you have already paid and remains with Revenue if not claimed by a charity on your behalf. By completing the necessary form, our Parish as an eligible charity, can claim this tax. To qualify for this scheme, you must have donated €250 or more to the Parish.

Note for Self-Employed: From the 1st January 2013 the rules of the scheme have changed and our Parish can now avail of a tax refund in respect of contributions made by Self-employed as well as PAYE workers. Again we thank everyone for your continued support.
