Witnessing to the Christian Way

If any organisation or institution puts itself first and not the people it is supposed to serve do we all turn a blind eye to that? Its worth thinking about.

Another is - we Catholics cannot define ourselves as good Christians only by the fact we go to Mass. How we are during the week with people - how we talk about them or deal with them - worth thinking about too.

This might be worth thinking about too - you might be the only gospel which people read - your life -

By your deeds you are known.
