

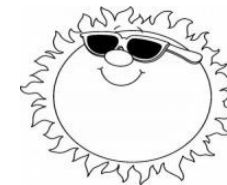

A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed....



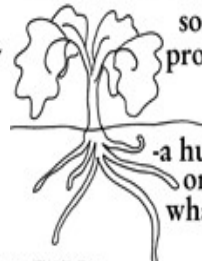
Some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up...

Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop - a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown.

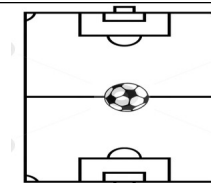
