

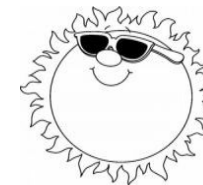

Trócaire Urgent Appeal

An emergency Collection in aid of Trócaire's work in East Africa will take place in our Parish this weekend. **Fiona Shanahan** from Kilmurry who works with Trócaire will speak at all Masses in the Parish this weekend. Nearly 23million people in Somalia, Kenya & Ethiopia are currently in urgent need of food & water due to drought. Trócaire is reaching over 150,000 people across the region with emergency food, water & satiation. Needs are enormous — **please support our appeal and help us reach more people with life-saving aid.**
