"..And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us". - As human beings, we are all imperfect.

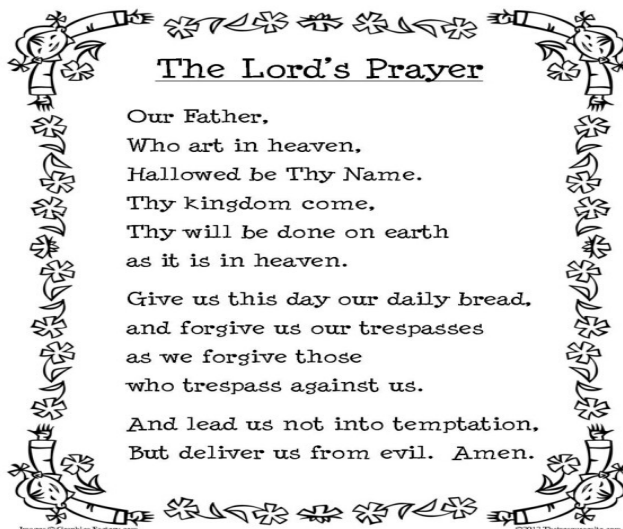
"..and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil". Often our faulty egos can lead us into temptation and lead us astray. This is where we must ask God to show us His light.
