Welcome Bishop Elect Fintan Monahan

We congratulate and warmly welcome Fr. Fintan Monahan as our new Bishop Elect. We wish him well as we journey together in our Diocese of Killaloe.

Fintan Monahan was born in Tullamore, Co Offaly, on 23 January 1967. His parents are Tom and Peg Monahan and he has one brother, Seán, and one sister, Caitríona, who is married to Dominic. From 1980-1996 the family lived in Carraroe, Co Galway where his father was principal teacher at Scoil Chuimsitheach Chiaráin, An Cheathrú Rua. In 1996 the family moved to Castlegar, Galway City, the native home of his mother. Primary education was in Tullamore and secondary education was in Carraroe before studying for the priesthood for the Archdiocese of Tuam in Saint Patrick's College, Maynooth in 1984. Ordination to the priesthood was in Séipéal Mhic Dara, An Cheathrú Rua on 16 June 1991 by Archbishop Joseph Cassidy. While studying for the H.Dip. in Education in Galway he was curate in An Tulach, Baile na hAbhann, Conamara from 1992-1993. From 1993-2006 he taught Science, Irish and Religion at the diocesan college, Saint Jarlath's College in Tuam, along with coaching basketball and hurling.

In 2006 Archbishop Michael Neary appointed him chaplain to Saint Jarlath's College and diocesan secretary.

Bishop-elect Fintan is a fluent Irish speaker and enjoys the outdoor life, hill walking, jogging, cycling, swimming and gardening. In his introductory words on Friday Fr. Fintan finished by saying. ... "There is a job to be done. The sleeves are rolled up. I'm

happy to join the meitheal of work that is on-going in this prayerful community of faith that is Killaloe Diocese. May the Lord be with us all as we continue our work for the Lord.

In the words of the ancient Irish 17th Century Prayer often said when embarking on a journey:
