It is with regret that the Sixmilebridge Community Playground is now closed due to the €5000 worth of damage caused by anti social behaviour and unsupervised children from our community. As this is a community owned playground it will remain closed until community support to repair and maintain it is received. Volunteers are urgently required to assist in whatever capacity they can, as currently we are operating with a committee of four, which is exceptionally poor, considering there are approximately 600 children in our community school and roughly 200 children in our local creches. Nearly all of these reside in the environs of Sixmilebridge and use these facilities. Please come along and help in our efforts - meetings are held at 7.30pm every Tuesday in the Bridge Active Building.
