In his weekly General Audience on Wednesday in  
 St Peter's Square, Pope Francis devoted his reflection to  
 the theme of loss in the family: the pain and suffering  
 that the passing of a family member can bring, and the  
 duty we have to comfort and console those who mourn.  
 He told assembled pilgrims that "one of the more  
 dramatic and painful events" that every person, without  
 exception, has to deal with, is the death of a family  
 member.

"Jesus has compassion on those who mourn because the  
 death of a loved one is never without pain for families",  
 Pope Francis said and added, "This is especially true of  
 parents who lose a child."

His comments were made as the parents of the five Irish  
 students and one American student who tragically lost  
 their lives on Tuesday in Berkeley, California, began to  
 arrive as well as the parents of the seven other students  
 who were seriously injured when the balcony they were  
 standing on collapsed.

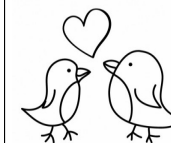
### Sixmilebridge G.A.A. Annual Scrap Metal.
