On June 21st Pope Francis celebrated 100 days as Pope. Speaking with some school children three weeks ago, he explained how he preferred to live in Community rather than on his own in the imposing Papal apartments. **"It is to keep my sanity"** he explained with a broad smile.

On that same 21st June I celebrated my Golden Jubilee to the Priesthood. It was an extraordinary experience. It was a great Community experience. Thanks again to all who were involved in the organisation of the event. It was a humbling but hugely affirmative experience. It brought back a lot of memories.

Above all I was hugely proud of the people of this Parish. Several people commented on the extraordinary community spirit. It brought home to me the qualities of a genuine community and what it means to people in so many ways. The Pope said community keeps him sane. We are fortunate to have it.
