THE WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES

The event is taking place in Dublin from Aug 22-26th.

The **first part** of the event is a 3 Day Congress consisting of talks, workshops, events, and family fun and activities in the RDS. It's a wonderful opportunity for families to come together and celebrate what it means to be part of the circle of love and care, that is family.

There are lots of fun activities for children and young people and all children under 18 are free.

The **second part** of the event is the arrival of Pope Francis on Saturday and he will be present at the festival through music and song in Croke Park on Saturday night. The Holy Father will be chief celebrant of the Papal Mass in the Phoenix Park on Sunday afternoon.

To attend the event you **MUST** register and have a ticket for all members of your family attending, including children under 18. You will not be admitted if you do **NOT** have a ticket.

Presently the only tickets that are available are for the 3 Day Congress from Wednesday August 22 to Friday August 24. The fee for an adult to attend for 1 day is 38 euro up to 70 euro for the 3 full days. If you attend for any day of the congress you are guaranteed tickets for the celebrations with the Pope on Saturday and Sunday.

Presently there are **NO** tickets available for Saturday and Sunday, except through registering for the Congress. So when you register for any day of the congress you'll be guaranteed tickets for Saturday and Sunday.

Over the coming weeks general tickets for the Saturday and Sunday events will become available and will be **FREE**.
