NEW SPIRIT - NEW HOPE - NEW LIFE

Pentecost is regarded as the Feast that celebrates the birthday of Christianity. For the first time, the followers of Jesus had the courage to go out into the world and proclaim that He was the Messiah, that He had Risen, that He would come again, that He would never leave us alone. He would send His Spirit.

After He had gone they were filled with fear - afraid of the world. It was only when Jesus made good on His promise to send the Spirit that the disciples were able to face the world with courage -
