We sometimes use quite physical imagery to describe our reaction to a sad situation - our 'heart goes out' to someone or we find an experience 'gut wrenching' or 'heart breaking'. Jesus felt sorry for the widow who had just lost her only son. His compassion is for the heart broken mother who is a widow. Compassion is one of the great gifts. A genuinely compassionate person is a treasure. A compassionate community, which, by and large, we are privileged to belong to is vital. How often do we hear at a time of a funeral - 'the neighbours are great', and they usually are.

Finally, I think we can say with a fair degree of certainty that religion is waste of time without compassion. And this includes being sensitive to other people, especially at a time of hardship and loss for many.

We know that a lot of people experience the compassionate power of Jesus at work in many different ways, informally from neighbours and friends but also in *Alcoholics Anonymous*, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Special Olympics and many more.

Thank God for it - in ourselves and others.
