The topic impacts on a lot of lives. People either have a personal experience of depression or know somebody with it. But What exactly is it? That was the title of Dr. Terry Lynch's talk. He explained it in plain simple language. We all understood what he was saying. We also understood that we were only opening up the subject. This is important because as he said 'when we try to push things away they come back with a vengeance'. Terry dealt with the subject in a very sensitive way.
