

I often meet people in our community who, not matter what, never allow their spirit to be broken. No matter what cross they have to carry their inner strength carries them through. Every Tuesday morning the children for First Communion gather for Mass. They recite the prayers of the Mass together. It is a joy to hear so many young people in prayer and so enthusiastic about coming. If this is special for the children then it must be special for the parents and all of us adults too.
