

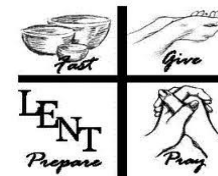

The blind man in the gospel insisted that it was Jesus who cured him and gave him his sight but the people didn't believe him. Believing therefore is beyond seeing.

We also have our own blindness. We sometimes experience blindness, not necessarily physical blindness but spiritual blindness. We may have healthy eyes but can hardly see God because our eyes are blurred by impure lenses. We become blind when we only see and focus on ourselves. The blind man in the Gospel has been cured and has seen and recognised Jesus, unlike the people who refused to recognise Jesus because they were blinded by their pride, self-righteousness and arrogance.

We pray that we will open our eyes, so we can see God and our brothers and sisters, especially the poor and the needy.



Prayer: Almighty and Ever-living God, open our eyes to see you and our hearts to love you so we can recognise you in our brothers and sisters and in the daily events of our lives. Heal us from every physical and spiritual sickness, especially when we are blinded because of pride, arrogance and ego where we project our false self. Heal us Lord so we may follow you closely. This we ask through Christ our Lord, Amen.
