The Poorest of the Poor

We are called on, during Lent to contribute to the fight against poverty and overcome injustice. We can do this through Trocaire. We are now half way through Lent. By now there should be a Trocaire Box or envelope in every home.

The young girl on this years' Trocaire box is a five year old and lives in North Honduras with her family. The people in her community of 500 families work the land to earn an income. But yields are so low they barely make enough to pay for food and clothing. They are persecuted by a tyrant landlord.

Trocaire is trying to help these people and they have asked us to contribute a little to help them do that.

We would like our community to be generous. We are fully aware these are not easy times for many here at home. But it's in giving we receive. Very often the most generous are people who may not have a lot.

We would especially ask people like Confirmation and Holy Communion children to give a little of what they get in gifts on their big day. Let us make a special effort this Lent to give a little so that others might live.

Eamon Meehan a Clare man who has worked in the Third World with Trocaire will talk at all the Masses next weekend.

We all know that it's in giving we receive. Eamon will help us to link to the lives of the poorest of the poor and hopefully inspire us to pray for that work and to give a little so that others can live.
