In a special way this Lent we think about water. We can forget about it around here. We have a lot of it. We complain about the rain. But, thank God we are so fortunate. Water gives life to plants and to people. We are told to drink a few pints of it each day. It removes the toxins from our bodies. It cleans us out. We use it all the time for washing - ourselves and everything around us.

This weekend we welcome Hannah Evans to talk to us about the work of Trócaire. This year we are reminded of **Enestina** from Malawi, who journeys 2km with 20 litres of water every morning before school. She is one of the millions of women and girls who make the hazardous journey to wells every day in search of water. According to the U.N. 1.1 billion people are 'water insecure'.

Trócaire is working in Malawi with their local partners to provide water security for many communities. By 2020 it is estimated that water available for agriculture in the region will drop by 50%.

We all have a part to play in this with climate change one of the biggest contributors to water shortage. This is a problem that requires more than charity giving to solve.

This Lent, through Trócaire's Lenten Campaign we are asked to especially think about the global water crisis. By now you will have received your Trócaire boxes and envelopes. Towards the end of Lent we will identify a weekend for returning these to the Parish so that we as a Christian Community can be generous in helping those people in Malawi to provide a basic necessity for life and living.
