

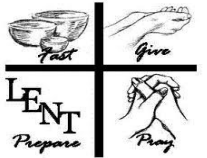

 for families separated by war or conflict.

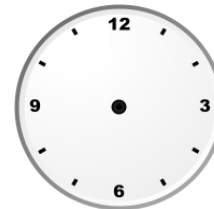


Lord, give them your special Blessing. We remember with Love and Gratitude all our mothers living and dead on this Mother's Day.
